

# Instructions for growing your Comber Earlies

Thank you for joining us in growing some PGI Comber Earlies, which are now Comber's most famous potatoes!

Here is your growing pack, which is a gift to you from the growers. Your pack contains:

- One tub
- One pack of compost
- Potato chits (the seed)

To grow these famous potatoes just follow these six simple steps

- 1) Pour 20mm of soil into the pot
- 2) Place your Comber Early Chit (Seed) in the soil around 20mm from the bottom of the post with the chit (pointy white part at the top of the potato) at the top.
- 3) Cover in Soil
- 4) Water twice a week
- 5) Watch for some green sprouts
